Saturday, April 25, 2 p.m.: Visits to Member-Wineries *Windward Vineyard* and *Austin Hope Winery* - library vintages

Sunday, April 26, 11 a.m.: Visit to *Justin Vineyards & Winery* followed by grand luncheon featuring vertical of *Reserve Isosceles*

We are pleased to bring you a week-end of camaraderie and enjoyment as we learn more about the beautiful Paso Robles AVA, a viticultural area that is gaining increasing international prominence and prestige due to the outstanding quality of its wines.

On Saturday, Marc Goldberg and his lovely wife Maggie, proprietors of *Windward Vineyard*, will introduce us to their meticulous vineyards. We will then taste some library vintages of magnificent Pinot Noir made in the traditional Burgundian style, all accompanied by generous antipasti.

At 4 p.m., we will journey one block to the new winery that has been built by our member Austin Hope. As many of you know, Austin has long been a devotee of Côte Rotie. He has received many accolades for his impressive Rhone-style wines, and we look forward to hearing how he was influenced by the vineyards and wine-making style of that part of France. Once again, library vintages will be tasted--- Marsanne, Meritage, and Syrah. Delicious artisan cheeses carefully selected to suitably complement the wines will accompany our tasting.

We will start bright and early on Sunday with a sojourn to the 160 acres in the remote Adelaide Valley west of Paso Robles, home of one of the Central Coast's wine pioneers, *Justin Vineyards & Winery*. All the wines made here are produced from estate-grown fruit. Our members Justin and Debby Baldwin, proprietors, have pulled out all the stops to give us a truly memorable experience. They will receive us in their impressive *Isosceles Center*. Following a tasting accompanied by delectable nibbles, we will adjourn to their elegant barrel chai where we will be treated to an afternoon of magnificent wines, food and fellowship. We will enjoy an extraordinary four-course, sit-down luncheon in the gracious and uncompromising style for which Justin and Debby have long been well-known. The highlight of the afternoon will be a *vertical* of the legendary *Reserve Isosceles* (a Bordeaux-style blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Cabernet Franc) which, as many of you know, is not available for purchase through retailers.
